The haptic quality exhibited by the solid aluminium housing of the compact Ice Cube is extremely pleasing. Its configuration is also more than adequate. A fixed subsonic filter, a sensibly designed deep bass boost function and the automatic switch-on mechanism go far beyond the usual features. The latter can even be adapted to the source and set to either respond to the bridge output stages of normal car radios or on an existing music signal. The 8" driver, which is also above average, operates with an extremely firm aluminium cone. After unscrewing the unit you will only find a tiny amount of electronics, which creates little hope for a powerful performance. However, appearances can deceiving! What we are dealing with here is a cutting-edge digital mini amplifier that not only pushes out over 80 watts at 1 ohm(!), but also delivers an amazing performance with optimum distortion values!
